**Resolution of Electors to Abolish the Office of Town Constable**

WHEREAS, s. 60.10 (1)(b) 4. of Wis. Stats. authorizes the town electors of a town to abolish the office of the Town Constable;

WHEREAS, the annual town meeting of the electors has been called for this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, the annual town meeting of the Town of Poygan, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2012 duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, the town electors of the Town of Poygan, Winnebago County, Wisconsin hereby abolish the office of the Town Constable.

The town clerk shall properly post this resolution in 3 places or publish this resolution once in a qualified newspaper as required by law under s. 60.80 of Wis. Stats. within 30 days of adoption.

Adopted this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2012, at the Annual Town Meeting.
